2010 Official Rules and Entry Form

DCU (Digital Federal Credit Union) recognizes the lifetime value of a college education. The DCU Memorial Scholarship Program is designed to assist outstanding students with the cost of this education. In 2010, we will award the following scholarships to members who are graduating high school seniors judged most likely to excel at a college or university. The judging of the students will be conducted by an impartial panel of three college-level instructors and/or admissions officers.

Five \$2,500 Scholarships
Fifteen \$1,000 Scholarships

We must receive your entry by March 12, 2010. Scholarship winners will be notified by the end of May.

Official Rules

- 1. Judging criteria** – The winning students will be the ones judged most likely to excel in college as determined by an impartial panel of three college-level instructors and/or admissions officers. They will base their judgments on the following factors:
 - an **official transcript** of your high school grades for senior year (to date) and junior year (full year),
 - academic merit,
 - references from **two senior class** teachers,
 - an essay judged on the quality of writing and the reasoning used,
 - awards and recognition,
 - and extracurricular and community service activities.
- 2. Entry qualifications** – To enter, the student must...
 - be a graduating high school senior,
 - be planning to attend a state-accredited or nationally-accredited two or four-year college or university,
 - and the **student must be a DCU member** in good standing.

DCU employees, volunteers, and their immediate family members are ineligible.
- 3. The Essay** – The essay should answer “**Why I should receive a DCU scholarship**” and...
 - be no more than 300 words in length,
 - be double-spaced,
 - have one-inch margins,
 - typed on a computer or typewriter,
 - have your name, address, and telephone number near the top,
 - stapled in the upper left corner.
- 4. Schedule** – Entries must be received at the address listed above by March 12, 2010. Judging will take place during March and April. Winners will be notified by mail by the end of May.
- 5. Publicity** – By entering winners agree to have their names published in DCU newsletters, signs, web site, and news releases announcing the results at DCU’s discretion.
