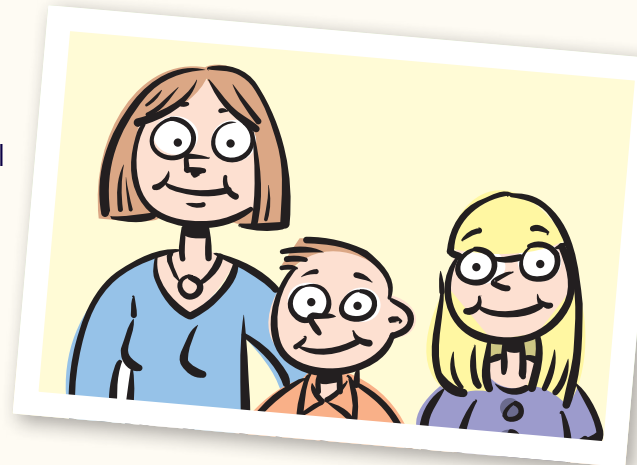
○ MARVELOUS MOTHER'S DAY IDEAS

- 4. Create a bouquet of chores.** Think of ways you can help around the

house, such as putting away all your toys, emptying the trash, or walking the dog. Then write them on craft sticks and attach homemade paper flowers to the tops. Tie them together for a special bouquet.

- 5. Personalize a bookmark.** If your mom likes to read, make her a bookmark decorated with a favorite poem, beautiful pictures, or a photo of you.
- 6. Make a door hanger.** Write Do Not Disturb on a piece of cardboard, and then make it beautiful with paint, markers, or anything else. Attach a string across the top and encourage mom to hang it on her bedroom door when she wants some time alone.



- 7. Craft a You and Me book.** Include a photo of you and your mom, a poem written especially for her, a list of your favorite things to do together, and anything else you can think of.
- 8. Make a coupon book.** Include tickets for back rubs, hugs, control of the TV remote for one day, a car wash, or one hour of silence. The options are endless!
